EDUCATION

Osgoode Hall Law School (LL.B) (1970 to 1971) University of Windsor (B.Sc) (1968 to 1969) Harvey Strosberg is a class-action pioneer. He has appeared as counsel in more than 40 class action certification motions and has recovered over \$1.5 billion for his class action clients on some of the most important cases in Canadian history. It is not hard to see why Harvey Strosberg made history in class actions, and why he is affectionately referred to as the 'King of Torts'.

Harvey was called to the bar in 1971 and became a Queen's Counsel (now King's Counsel) in 1982. He has vast trial and appellate experience in the areas of class actions, negligence, commercial law, product liability and insurance law. In 1995, Harvey served as the first Board chair of LPIC, the organisation which eventually became LawPro. Harvey is the Editor of the Canadian Class Action Review. In 2004, Harvey established the annual Harvey T. Strosberg Essay Prize in class actions in the amount of \$10,000. Harvey also taught a course in class action law at the University of Windsor law school. Harvey was named a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers in 1991.

Harvey's achievements and his contribution to our justice system are reflected in the number of awards of distinction he has received: The Law Society Medal in 2010, an Honourary Doctor of Laws degree (LLD) granted by the Law Society of Upper Canada in 2002, an Honourary Doctor of Laws degree (LLD) granted by Assumption University in 2004 and an Honourary Doctor of Common Law (DCL) granted by the University of Windsor in 2023.
